Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



I am over the age of 35, can I apply?

Two categories of persons can apply: students and artists under the age of 35. If you are over the age of 35, you can apply as a student. You should therefore be inscribed in an artistic university or should have been for the 2016/2017 academic year (or more recently 2017/2018 and 2018/2019).

When will the results be announced?

The jury selecting the laureates will take place at the end of November; we will give you the exact date at a later stage. At the end of the jury, the laureates will be announced on the Culture and Creation website of the Grand Paris Express and if your application is selected, we will contact you.

I do not have a territory of preference; can I still apply?

You do not have to choose a territory. If there isn't a particular territory on which you would like to work, it will be allocated to you during the jury. In your application letter, the idea is to show your ability of adaptation and comprehension of any territory, with a view to building a story-line. Whether you have expressed a preference for a territory or not, the decision attributing a territory to an artist ultimately comes back to the jury.

Can I apply alone AND with a collective?

Only one email address is allowed to apply. If you apply in your name and in the name of a collective, please designate a person other than yourself as representative of the group. If you apply as a group or with a collective, the names of all of the members should appear.
